

GRAPEFRUIT GOLF CLUB COVER

This golf club cover is designed for the oversized drivers that many golfers use today. It is knit, bottom up, in the round on two circular needles. The bottom ruffle is added last. For a more masculine cover, eliminate the ruffle. Remember in golf, the tackier the better!

SIZE One size fits most large drivers 14” circumference

MATERIALS

Laines Du Nord, Dolly Maxi 100% Merino, superwash; Main Color: #910, 1 ball; Contrast Color A: #911, 1 ball; Contrast Color B: #4, 1 ball

2 sets US size 9, 24” circular needles, or size to obtain gauge

Scrap yarn

Tapestry Needle

GAUGE 20 stitches = 4”, 18 rows = 4”

CLUB COVER

Bottom Ribbing

With Scrap yarn cast on 64 stitches, place half of the stitches on each of the two circular needles. Mark beginning of round and join. Using main color, work 2x2 rib, in the round for 24 rounds.

Next round: Using contrast color A, work one round in 2x2 rib

Next round: Using main color, work one round in 2x2 rib

Work these two rounds 3 more times

Next round: Using contrast color A, work one round in 2x2 rib

Polka Dots

Work the next 18 rows per chart in stockinette stitch. Be careful to carry the yarn loosely in the back so that your work does not pucker.

Top Decreases

Next round: Using main color, [K6, k2tog], repeat to end, 56 stitches remain.

Next round: Using contrast color A, knit.

Next round: Using main color, [K5, k2tog], repeat to end, 48 stitches remain.

Next round: Using contrast color A, knit.

Next round: Using main color, [K4, k2tog], repeat to end, 40 stitches remain.

Next round: Using contrast color A, knit.

Next round: Using main color, [K3, k2tog], repeat to end, 32 stitches remain.

Next round: Using contrast color A, knit.

Next round: Using main color, [k2, k2tog], repeat to end 24 stitches remain.

Next round: Using contrast color A, [K1, k2tog]; repeat to end, 16 stitches remain.

Next round: Using main color, k2tog, repeat to end, 8 stitches remain.

Next round: Using contrast color A, k2tog, repeat to end, 4 stitches remain.

Draw the working yarn through the remaining stitches and pull to inside of work.

Bottom Ruffle

Carefully remove scrap yarn and place the live stitches on the needle. You should have 64 stitches.

Next round: Using main color, knit.

Next round: Using contrast color B, knit front and back of each stitch for entire round. You now have 128 stitches on the needle.

Next round: Using contrast color B, knit.

Next round: Using contrast color A, knit.

Next round: Using contrast color B, knit.

Next round: Using contrast color A, bind off.

Finishing

Weave in all ends. Block lightly if desired.
